SNOWDROPS

Snowdrops are just beautiful, and they are one of the first plants to flower as early as January! They like shade, and are normally found in woodland.

Plants have 'proper' latin names, as well as their common names. Snowdrops are also known as 'Galanthus Nivalis', which comes from the Greek words 'Gala' meaning milk, 'Anthos' meaning flower and 'Nivalis' meaning snow. So Snowdrops are milk flowers of the snow!







